Herkimer, NY—Herkimer County Community College recently entered into new transfer agreements with SUNY Maritime College, Cornell University and Berkeley College.

The agreement with SUNY Maritime College allows HCCC students who complete the Associate in Science degree in Business Administration, with a minimum 2.5 grade point average, guaranteed admission into the Bachelor of Science degree program in International Transportation & Trade. Maritime College will accept up to 75 transfer credits from HCCC.

A guarantee transfer program with the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences (CALS) at Cornell University is designed for graduates of HCCC's Liberal Arts & Sciences: Science degree program. Students can transfer into one of numerous programs including Agricultural Sciences, Biological Engineering, Food Science, Natural Resources, Plant Science and more with full junior status. A minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average is required; grades of C or better will transfer to Cornell.

HCCC students who wish to transfer to Berkeley College must complete an associate degree with an overall grade point average of 2.0 to transfer into the parallel program at Berkeley. HCCC students enrolled in International Business, Human Resource Management, Health Services Management, Business Administration, Marketing, Fashion Buying and Merchandising, Accounting or Criminal Justice will be accepted into Berkeley's parallel programs. Berkeley will offer scholarships of up to \$5000 per academic year to HCCC associate degree graduates.
